

CDFA TREATMENT SCHEDULE ORIENTAL FRUIT FLY

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) is scheduled to apply bait stations in the treatment area every 2 weeks for 2 life cycles of the fruit fly. The number of days in the fly's life cycle is temperature dependent, so the exact number of treatments cannot be predicted. Current models project about 8 weeks for the 2 life cycles and about 5 treatments.

3 rd treatment:	August 29, 2006
4 th treatment:	September 12, 2006 (FINAL TREATMENT)
