Psychiatric Experience

My experience is extensive as Chief of Staff, Medical Director, Quality Assurance Director, and Utilization Review Director in JCAHO and non-JCAHO hospitals, including the Department of Veteran's Affairs Inpatient Medical Director, Intensive & Partial hospitalization programs, and outpatient services. While performing these administrative duties I maintained a full practice of more than 40 hours a week.

- Feb 2014 – Present LA County DMH, providing outpatient treatment services.
- Jan 2017 – Present Locum Tenens physician, providing, outpatient services to San Fernando Valley Community Mental Health Center, Van Nuys, CA.
- Nov 2009 – Present Locum Tenens physician, providing, inpatient and outpatient services throughout central and southern California to both private and public entities.
- Jan 2008 – Oct 2009 As the lead Mental Health professional I am primarily assigned to the Deployment Health Clinic (DHC), 13 Area ABMC, Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton, Port Hueneme, California. The Deployment Health Clinic was established to provide a means to identify and address health concerns of service members, with a specific emphasis on mental health, that have emerged in the three- to six- month time period after return from deployment. As the lead provider is a part of the "Mental Health component" of the Deployment Health Clinic, in addition to a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, two Clinical Psychologist and mental health technicians. I provide clinical supervision over mental health technicians who conduct the mental health screenings. In addition, I provide follow-up psychiatric care, primarily psychiatric medication management, for identified service members, in sites where they are co-located with Primary Care providers dispersed throughout Camp Pendleton/Port Hueneme. There is an emphasis on identifying and treating combat/operational stress concerns, especially Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). I provide limited case management services (e.g., tracking referrals, facilitating access to care, monitoring treatment

received). Finally, I provide and support educational and outreach efforts, at various levels, from individual service members, to caregivers (e.g., primary care physicians, chaplains), to command level officers. The hope of the military is that I assist in de-stigmatizing mental health service-seeking, promoting the benefits of early identification and treatment of mental health problems, and overcoming military cultural norms against full symptom reporting out of concern for appearing “weak.” I closely collaborate with members of the DHC Mental Health component on all aspects of program design, service delivery, monitoring and evaluation.

Dec 2006 – Dec 2007 Chief of Staff/Medical Director, Acadia Vermilion Hospital, Lafayette, LA. The hospital provided inpatient, partial hospitalization, and outpatient services to mostly adults from Lafayette but also patients throughout the state of Louisiana.

Jan 2007 – Mar 2007 Psychiatrist, Downtown Mental Health, Los Angeles, CA. Provide outpatient services to patients in metropolitan Los Angeles.

Dec 2005 – Dec 2006 Chief of Staff. Liberty Health Care Systems. Ruston, LA. Liberty Health Care provides psychiatric services through out north central Louisiana.
