

RESOLUTION NO. GPAC 2007-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE ISLA VISTA GENERAL PLAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDING THAT THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION AND BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO ADOPT THE ISLA VISTA MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 65351 requires that during the preparation or amendment of a general plan, opportunities be provided for the involvement of citizens, public agencies, public utility companies, and civic, education, and other community groups, through public hearings and any other means the city or county deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 1991 the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 91-211, adopting Guidelines for General Plan Advisory Committees and Similar Advisory Bodies, that prescribe GPAC operation procedures and responsibilities (hereinafter County GPAC Guidelines); and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2000, the Board of Supervisors and the Board of Directors of the Redevelopment Agency adopted a Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Santa Barbara, the University of California at Santa Barbara, and the Isla Vista Recreation and Park District to develop a Master Plan for Isla Vista ("Master Plan"), a General Plan update; and

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2002, the Board of Supervisors formed the Isla Vista General Plan Advisory Committee to advise the County regarding potential amendments and updates to the Countywide General Plan through the development of the Master Plan for Isla Vista; and


WHEREAS, if adopted, the proposed Master Plan for Isla Vista will update the County General Plan for Isla Vista; and

WHEREAS, the Isla Vista General Plan Advisory Committee held more than 31 public hearings in the Isla Vista community to assist in the preparation of the Draft Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2003 the Isla Vista General Plan Advisory Committee recommended the initiation of environmental review of the Isla Vista Master Plan to the Board of Supervisors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Isla Vista General Plan Advisory Committee that after careful review of the draft Isla Vista Master Plan, the GPAC recommends to the Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors the approval of the Isla Vista Master Plan.
