

# **Isla Vista Project Area Committee (PAC) Role, Responsibility and Commitments**

## **PAC: Role**

The Isla Vista Project Area Committee (PAC) will serve two roles. First, pending final Board approval, the PAC will serve as an advisory body that will help develop the master plan and make recommendations to staff, the County Planning Commission and the Board of Supervisors. Second, the PAC will review certain types of redevelopment plan amendments that affect low and moderate-income residents<sup>1</sup> and make recommendations to the Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors.

## **PAC: Requirements**

- The Isla Vista PAC will be subject to the Brown Act, which means that all meetings will be noticed and open to the public. Members of the public are allowed to speak at PAC meetings, subject to reasonable time constraints. Minutes of the meetings will be taken (including votes) and made available.
- PAC members must avoid conflict of interest when reviewing the master plan.

## **PAC Commitments**

- The PAC will meet 1 – 2 times per month for approximately one year. PAC members are required to attend evening meetings and review background material. It is estimated that PAC members will be required to devote approximately 15 hours per month to the project. The PAC will continue to meet occasionally after the draft master plan is prepared.
