That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize the Chair to sign **three original copies** of the attached Amendment #2 to the Joint Powers Agreement between the City of Lompoc and the County of Santa Barbara regarding the operation of the Lompoc Transit System.

**ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:**

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goals 2 and 5: To ensure public health and safety, to provide essential infrastructure, and to maintain and enhance the quality of life for all residents.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:**

The City of Lompoc operates the Lompoc Transit System. The City and County have a Joint Powers Agreement which enables the Transit System to operate in the unincorporated Vandenberg Village, Mesa Oaks and Mission Hills areas north of the City. The attached amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement provides for some minor alterations to the transit system's operations in regards to monthly bus passes and the minimum age of unescorted children riding the bus. In summary, these amendments are:

1. The establishment of a \$28 monthly pass that will allow a person to travel within Lompoc Transit's service area an unlimited number of times within a month.

2. The establishment of a \$14 monthly pass that will allow a senior or disabled citizen to travel within Lompoc Transit's service area an unlimited number of times within a month.
3. A provision that anyone under the age of seven must be accompanied by a parent or a person 14 years of age or older when riding a Lompoc Transit bus.
