SUBJECT: Construction of Hollister Street Drainage Improvements in the Town of Los Olivos
County Project No. 310264 - CIP No. 9825
Third Supervisorial District

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve the plans and specifications for the Construction of Hollister Street Storm Drainage Improvements in the Town of Los Olivos, Project No. 310264;
- B. Award and authorize the Chair to execute the construction contract in the amount of \$178,660.50 to the lowest responsible bidder of John Madonna Construction Company at P. O. Box 5310 in San Luis Obispo, California, subject to the provisions of documents and certifications as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to this project as required under California Law; and
- C. Approve a contingency fund in the amount of \$17,866.00 for the construction of this project.

Subject: Construction of the Hollister Street Drainage Improvements in the Town of Los Olivos

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Executive Summary and Discussion:

On April 8, 1999 the Public Works Department received and opened ten bids for the Hollister Street Drainage Improvement Project. The lowest responsible bid submitted was by John Madonna Construction Company in the amount of \$178,660.50, which was 1% below the Engineer's Estimate for this project.

The project consists of the construction of a new storm drain system along Hollister Street in the town of Los Olivos. The stormdrain system will collect stormwater runoff along Grand Avenue and Hollister Street and then conveys the flow to Alamo Pintado Creek.

This project was reviewed by the Capital Advisory Committee and Capital Improvement Committee and is recommended for funding in the proposed FY 98/99 Capital Improvement Plan.

Mandates and Service Levels:

Approval by the Board of Supervisors will not effect or change any programs or service levels.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

Funding for this project will come from the Road Division's Measure D funds for the Third Supervisorial District. Funds have been budgeted in Department No. 054, Fund No. 0015, Account No. 7510 and Program No. 2900.
