SUBJECT: Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fees

RECOMMENDATION(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Conduct a second reading and adopt the Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee Ordinance authorizing new Sheriff Fees for new development; and
- B. Adopt a resolution setting specific Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee levels for new development.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN: The recommendation(s) are primarily aligned with Goal No. 2. A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit; Goal No. 4. A Community that is Economically Vital and Sustainable; and Goal No. 5. A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION: On March 23, 1999 your Board conducted the first reading of the Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee Ordinance and continued the hearing to April 20, 1999 for adoption (second reading) of the Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee ordinance and implementing fee resolution.

On April 20, 1999, Planning & Development requested that your Board continue the second reading and adoption of the Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee Ordinance from April 20, 1999 to May 25, 1999. This would allow your Board to review and further consider the total fee burden under the new and revised development impact fees prior to adopting the proposed Sheriff Development Impact Fee.

For more detailed information on the proposed Goleta Sheriff Development Impact Fee Ordinance, please refer to the March 23, 1999 Board Letter.

MANDATES AND SERVICE LEVELS: Government Code Section 66000 (AB 1600--Development Impact Fees) allows local jurisdictions to establish development impact fees to fund the construction of public infrastructure necessary to serve new development.

FISCAL AND FACILITIES IMPACTS: Funding to amend and adopt new ordinances and policies is contained in P&D's FY 1998-99 budget.
