Provide an update on the BRACE project, which was designed to provide individualized, assessment-driven services to Realigned jail inmates housed in the designated high-need mental health unit who suffer from co-occurring mental health and drug addiction issues, and who are at significant risk of returning to incarceration due to repetitive criminal activity.
- IX. **Update on Stepping Up Initiative and Sequential Intercept Mapping (SIM)** – Dr. Alice Gleghorn
Provide an update on the Stepping Up Initiative and on SIM, which is intended to illustrate how people with behavioral health needs come in contact with and flow through the criminal justice system, which aids in advancing system analysis and formulating policy decisions.
