## **ROUTE 192 FULL CLOSURE SCHEDULED FOR ROAD REALIGNMENT**

**SANTA BARBARA COUNTY** – A 700 foot section of Route 192/Stanwood Drive at Parma Park will be closed to traffic **24 hours a day** beginning Monday, April 21 until the end of June. This portion of Route 192 (Stanwood Drive) will be realigned away from Sycamore Creek which is threatening the stability of the roadway.

Motorists may detour by using Route 192 west to Mission Canyon Road, Alameda Padre Serra onto Barker Pass Road. Signs will be posted to assist motorists in moving through the project area. The road will also be closed to pedestrians and bicyclists.

The contractor for this \$640,000 project is Papich Construction of Grover Beach, CA.

Motorists can expect a delay not to exceed ten minutes.
