### **County Supervisor Janet Wolf Joins With State, City and School Officials To Highlight Completion of Cieneguitas Traffic Signal on Foothill Road (Highway 192)**

**WHO:** Santa Barbara County Second District Supervisor Janet Wolf to gather with Santa Barbara Mayor Pro Tem Dale Francisco; David Ortiz, principal of La Colina Junior High School; Command Officers from the local California Highway Patrol office; representatives from CalTrans and other County officials for an on-site press conference highlighting the completion of the new traffic signals at the Cieneguitas intersection with Foothill Road (Highway 192). Other dignitaries expected to join Supervisor Wolf include representatives for Bermant Development Co., and state Assemblyman Pedro Nava.

**WHAT:** The Press Conference highlights the recent completion of this important roadway safety project that is helping to protect local children and residents who must cross this busy intersection. The County’s Public Works Department worked in concert with CalTrans and the local developer, Bermant Development Co., to make the roadway safety project a reality
