**High Risk Groups Eligible for H1N1 Clinics**

Santa Barbara County is holding H1N1 vaccine clinics for individuals in our community who are in the following high risk groups identified by the Centers for Disease Control:

- *Pregnant women*
- *All children 6 months through 4 years of age*
- *Parents of infants 0 – 6 months*
- *Healthcare workers \**

The current supply of vaccine is not sufficient to provide vaccine to all at-risk patients. As soon as additional vaccine is received, additional clinics will be scheduled.
