The operator, Public Works, requests a review of changes proposed to the operation of the SCRTS. The changes involve updates to the Report of Station Information, including tonnage throughputs, average vehicle trips, procedure for processing green and wood wastes, entry signs, equipment lists, management personnel, operational layout, Fire Department Permit, and odor impact minimization plan.

Environmental Health Services (EHS) as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) under the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) approved the application on July 30, 2010.
