**SANTA MARIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY  
SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT APPLICATION**

**BACKGROUND:** On June 29, 2011, Santa Barbara County Environmental Health Services, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, received an application for a full solid waste facility permit regarding the Santa Maria Integrated Waste Management Facility (Facility # 42-AA-0076). The Solid Waste Disposal Site (landfill) is located approximately seven miles south of Santa Maria City center, at State Highway 101, Exit 161, Santa Maria, CA 93455, 34.823228 latitude and -120.355517 longitude.

The proposed Santa Maria Integrated Waste Management Facility application package reports the following facility details:

- A Class III lined landfill.
- A total of 617 permitted acres.
- A total of 286 disposal acres.
- A maximum permitted elevation of 1510 (Ft. MSL).
- A maximum of 1600 tons per day (disposal).
- A maximum of 277 vehicles per day.
- An estimated 90 years of capacity, with a design capacity of 130,850,000 cubic yards.
- Proposed facilities at the site include: entrance facility, scales, scale house, office, access roads, equipment maintenance building, recycling and resource recovery park area, agricultural plastics baling and recycling area, concrete and asphalt recycling area, landfill gas and energy recovery management system, storm water management facilities, leachate management system, groundwater monitoring, surface water monitoring, and landfill gas monitoring.

**LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY DETERMINATION:** The LEA will host a public meeting that is scheduled to take place on November 2, 2011. The purpose of the meeting is to make public the preliminary determination of the action to be taken by the LEA on the permit application. The LEA has made a preliminary determination that the application package is complete and correct, and the LEA will proceed with the processing of the permit application for approval.
