

Casmalia Community Services District (Casmalia CSD) Water System Retrofit Project

Prop 50 Funding

In a competitive grant for Integrated Regional Water Management monies under Proposition 50, the Casmalia Community Services District received \$631,700 from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) for the Water System Retrofit project.

Water System Retrofit Project

The project will replace portions of the water system that are in poor condition and/or that have exhibited poor reliability. This includes providing a replacement storage tank with capacity to meet current requirements; repair of the tank access road and adjacent piping and other system modifications as may be deemed necessary as a result of the engineering evaluation performed for this project.

Project Need

The community's existing water storage tank is over 28 years old and is showing signs of irreversible corrosion and decay. As a painted steel tank with no other protective coating, it has reached the end of its design life. The water supply system in Casmalia is in need of upgrades in order to prevent operational breakdowns and provide sufficient fire storage.

Project Benefits

The project is essential to providing Casmalia, a DAC, with a safe, secure water supply that is managed in an efficient manner. This project will also provide a public health improvement with respect to management and regulation.
