## **HWY. 101 PROJECT AT CATHEDRAL OAKS/HOLLISTER NOW UNDERWAY**

**GOLETA** - A project to realign Cathedral Oaks Road with Hollister Avenue and replace the Hwy. 101 Overcrossing at Hollister Avenue and the Ellwood Overhead at the Southern Pacific train tracks is now underway with tree removal/trimming for the next several weeks. There will be lane and ramp closures in the following areas next week:

- Hwy. 101 partial off-ramp closures in both directions from Hollister Avenue to Winchester Canyon Creek on Monday, Feb. 8 through Thursday, Feb. 11 from 8 am to 5 pm and on Friday, Feb. 12 from 8 am to 1 pm.
- Hwy. 101 northbound alternating lane closures in both directions from Hollister Avenue to Winchester Creek on Monday, Feb. 8 through Thursday, Feb. 11 from 6 am to 3 pm.

The contractor for this \$7 million project is Shasta Constructors Inc. of Redding CA.
