Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) is a collaborative effort to manage all aspects of water resources in a region. Water resources usually are not confined to the boundaries of a single water management agency. A consensus-based, cross-jurisdictional, regional approach can help water purveyors, planners, landowners, stakeholders, and others develop plans to better manage their water resources – including water supply, water quality, water use efficiency, and environmental protection. This 1-1/2 day conference will help water agencies, attorneys, elected officials, land use planners, environmentalists, tribes, and others identify key strategies to implement a successful IRWM plan.
