

Planning for Sea Level Rise at Goleta Beach County Park

Coastal Protection at Goleta Beach

- ▶ The Park has experienced over 40 years of coastal hazard response actions.
- ▶ Rock revetments currently protect the Park from storm-related erosion, while Park and beach access are still available.

- ▶ 1.5 Million Annual Visitors
- ▶ Largest source of free coastal parking in the South Coast



- ▶ Pier, restaurant, playground, BBQ and picnic areas, kayak and SUP rentals, horseshoes, fishing, and more!



Projected Sea Level Rise and Erosion

- ▶ Sea level rise and increased erosion in the future threatens the Park and its facilities.
- ▶ Recent studies indicate the importance of the revetments in Park protection. The County may be compelled to remove revetments, which may damage the Park, the pier, and the restaurant.
