

Continuing Education Online Classes

Continuing education courses must be completed before certificate or license expires. If you are short on hours, you will be required to re-take the exam. PAC holders must provide written documentation to the Agricultural Commissioner's Office that they have completed the necessary continuing education hours when renewing their PAC.

Private Applicator Certificate (PAC) continuing education requirements:

- Less than 12 months between issue and expiration dates: exempt from the continuing education requirement. *(exemption only applies for private applicators renewing for the 1st time)*
- 12 to 24 months between issue and expiration dates: 4 hours of CE, with at least 2 hours of Laws & Regulations
- 25 to 36 months between issue and expiration date: 6 hours of CE, with at least 2 hours of Laws and Regulations
