\*At the Allocations Committee meeting on February 4, 2021, the total funding available was estimated based on the prior year allocation. If the actual funding differed from the estimated, then the Allocations Committee directed staff to increase the recommended funding amount to Legal Aid Foundation if the CDBG allocation was more than estimated, and to decrease the funding amount to Domestic Violence Solutions if the CDBG allocation was less than estimated. The FY 2021 HUD allocation was announced on Monday, March 1, and funding recommendations have been updated accordingly.

Carpinteria projects are shown in italics.

These funding recommendations will be presented to the Board of Supervisors at a hearing on Tuesday, April 20, 2021.
