- Experience with cleaning and validating data sets for analytical consumption.
- Some coding experience in a modern software language, such as SQL, C#, Python, Java, or R. (Highly Desired)
- Skilled at explaining and summarizing technical information to non-technical people.
- Deep understanding of accounting and an eagerness to learn new technical and accounting concepts.
- Exceptional ability to think analytically and logically with a passion for using data and technology to solve organizational problems.

- Experience in project management and strategic planning.

3. A combination of training, education, and experience that is equivalent to one of the employment standards listed above and that provides the required knowledge and abilities.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. **Employment Standards Review:** Applications and supplemental questions will be reviewed to determine which applicants meet the employment standards.
2. **Resume Ranking:** Candidates that meet the employment standards will have their resumes evaluated and scored. Candidates' will be evaluated by the information provided on their **attached resume that demonstrates the skillset outlined in the ideal candidate section**.
3. **Oral Examination:** Candidates that pass the resume ranking will be contacted to perform an oral examination over the phone. The candidates' score on the eligibility list will be determined by their oral examination score. This process may be eliminated if there are fewer than eleven (11) qualified candidates.

Candidates must receive a percentage score of at least 70 on the oral examination to be placed on an employment list. An adjustment may be made to raw scores based on factors listed in Civil Service Rule VI. Those candidates who are successful in the selection process will have their names placed on the employment list for a minimum of three months. At the time the employment list is established, all candidates will receive an email notice of their score on the exam(s), rank on the employment list, and exact duration of the employment list.
