

## **BLOODBORNE PATHOGEN TRAINING FOR BODY ART PRACTITIONERS**

Body art practitioners are required to complete a bloodborne pathogen training course, specific to body art. Employees and volunteers that perform duties within the decontamination and sterilization or procedure area are also required to complete this course. An approved course must provide a minimum of two hours of training and be renewed annually. Training records must be kept on file for three years.
